- 3. Artisan Food Vendors must provide proper permits/applicable Health department approval, <u>along with proof of a commercial kitchen</u> (please note that the Market does not recognize "cottage food" permits for non-members).
- 4. Please do not use copyrighted logos, symbols, names, or characters on any of your product. This is a copyright law.
- 5. We are a "producer-only" market, meaning the producer must be present to sell their product. You may not hire other people to work your booth on a regular basis.
- 6. Artisan Food and Craft Vendors with storefronts are not eligible to participate in our market.
- 7. Value-added products <u>must</u> have proper labeling with product information as required by law.
