All products must be handmade or home grown to be eligible for sale at the Kootenai County Farmers' Market and must be made or grown by the child applying. Parents may do tasks that are not appropriate for younger children such as using sharp knives or loading/unloading an oven.

Products may not contain plastics (such as beads or flowers) and silk flowers are also not allowed.

Plants, veggies, baked goods, drinks and crafts are welcome. Please bring a sample of what you will be selling to the Saturday farmers market to Kendra at the Winifred Flower Farm booth (#7-8) with your completed application any Saturday OR bring it to the Manager's booth any Wednesday to have it juried for participation in Kids Day. Deadline for applications is August 5th to sell on August 9th OR August 12th to sell on August 19th.

## Things to know:

- Set up will be 8:30am on Saturday August 19<sup>th</sup>, teardown is at 1pm for the Saturday kids day OR Set up at 3:30pm on Wednesday August 9<sup>th</sup>, teardown is at 7pm.
- Bring: your own change (\$1's, \$5's, etc), a 4' or 5' table to sell on, shade umbrella, any table covers, signs, and your own chair on the day of Kids Day.
- The market has a program that allows customers to use their debit/credit cards to purchase red plastic tokens (\$10 increments) to be used at the booths in the market. If customers pay with these tokens, give them cash change and bring the tokens up to the manager's booth at the end of market to be reimbursed. Vendors may not accept EBT tokens, DUB tokens, or POP tokens (these are all wooden tokens) unless you are selling fresh fruits or vegetables.
